Oh, and Happy Father's Day to all you dads out there, make sure you celebrate a little bit extra this year, you deserve it!




(360) Burger from The Cattleman

Hand ground top sirloin and brisket ½ pound patty with pepper jack cheese, frizzled onions, smoked onion aioli, lettuce, tomato, and onion.

The Cattleman is located at 1506 West Yelm Ave

Ma's Burger from Ma & Pa's Family Diner

Burger with pepper jack cheese, bacon, jalapenos, tomato, lettuce, and spicy mayo.

Ma & Pa's is located at 203 West Yelm Ave

Mason Burger from Masonry Café & Catering

Half pound all beef patty, cheddar cheese, lettuce, tomato, house made pickles, red onions, stacked on a pub bun.

Masonry Café & Catering is located at 105 East Yelm Ave

Beast Burger from Mr. Dougs

Two patties, two strips of bacon, two types of cheeses, two onion rings, lettuce, tomato, and goop.

Mr. Dougs is located at 210 NE 103rd Ave
